NCUA Board Approves Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on Records Retention

The National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) Board held its third open meeting of 2024 and unanimously approved an **advance notice of proposed rulemaking** that solicits stakeholder comments on ways the agency can improve and update its records preservation program regulations and accompanying guidelines in Part 749 and other parts of the NCUA's rules and regulations.

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CFPB Updates Supervision Designation Procedures

The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) issued a **procedural rule** to update how the agency designates a nonbank for supervision. The updates will streamline the designation proceedings for both the CFPB and nonbanks.

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FTC Announces Rule Banning Noncompetes

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) has issued a **final rule** to promote competition by banning noncompetes nationwide, protecting the fundamental freedom of workers to change jobs, increasing innovation, and fostering new business formation.

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FinCEN Reminds Financial Institutions to Remain Vigilant to Environmental Crimes

As the nation reflects on the many ways to protect our environment this Earth Day, the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN) reminds financial institutions to remain vigilant in identifying and reporting suspicious activity related to environmental crimes. Environmental crimes frequently involve transnational criminal activity related to several of FinCEN's <u>Anti-Money</u> <u>Laundering and Countering the Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT) National</u> <u>Priorities</u>, including corruption, fraud, human trafficking, and drug trafficking.

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FinCEN updates Beneficial Ownership Information FAQs

FinCEN has updated its Beneficial Ownership Information FAQs to include new questions and updated information about reporting companies, beneficial ownership through trusts, and access to beneficial ownership information, among other topics.
